During the two-year program, students will have an opportunity to explore the many opportunities in Digital Media Arts, including: Audio and Video Production; 2D Video Animation; Graphic Design, Web Design and Development, Flash Animation, and Photography. Combining computer skills with personal creativity, the Digital Media Arts program gives students the basic skill set for a career and sets a foundation for future learning at the college level. Students learn communication and teamwork skills by working on larger projects with group members. Students also have their own individual challenges that are included in their portfolio upon completion of the class. Field trips, job shadowing, guest speakers and business partnerships help bring the workplace to the classroom in the Digital Media Arts program. We offer Adobe Certified Associate (ACA) and Adobe Certified Expert (ACE) certifications, along with CIW Site Design Specialists.
